Old North State Council High Adventure Committee Financial Aid Guidelines

1. The Scout or Venturer must show reasons for the financial aid request as documented in a letter from the Unit Leader, Unit Committee Member, or a Charter Organization Official.
2. The financial aid request must be recommended and approved by the Scoutmaster, or Crew Advisor. If the applicant is the child of the Scoutmaster or Crew Advisor a member of the Unit Committee or Charter Organization Official can recommend and approve the application.
3. Financial aid will be limited to one High Adventure Expedition a year, per youth who would otherwise be unable to participate in the expedition. The participant would normally not be allowed to receive a campership to attend Summer Camp Program the same year.
4. Reasons for High Adventure Financial Aid include the following: Single Parent Family, single income family, medical hardship, multiple youth or participants from same family, etc.
5. Financial Aid for High Adventure Activities is **generally limited to 50 percent of the total expedition fee**, including combination of scholarships received. For example: Total Expedition Fee is \$ 1000 so maximum financial aid is limited to \$ 500. If the participant receives a \$ 200 Campership from Northern Tier for a portion of the program fees any additional scholarship fees from Old North State Council funds would be limited to \$ 300. The only exception to this is when an individual scholarship awards more than 50 percent of the total expedition fee. The remaining 50 percent of the fees should be earned by the scout or venturer and/or provided by their troop or crew.
6. **The regular \$ 100 deposit must be paid and a Youth Application submitted at the time or before the financial aid request is submitted for consideration.** Since financial aid for high adventure activities is generally limited to a maximum of 50 percent of total fees, the participant or unit must make at least 50% payment of fees on all due dates.
7. Forms not properly filled out or lacking approvals or accompanying letters will be returned to the respective unit and not considered until completed properly.
8. All ONSC High Adventure Committee Requests must be submitted and received by the Scout Service Center **no later than September 15th of the year prior to the expedition** the participant is attending. Applications for other scholarships must meet the deadline for the appropriate scholarship and submit them to the proper address as listed on the application.
9. All financial aid requests will be considered by volunteer members of the High Adventure Committee.
10. Scouts, Venturers, and/or units should ask for only the amount of funds actually needed.
11. Scouts or Venturers applying for financial aid to Florida Sea Base or Northern Tier should also apply for the campership offered by these bases since this will make more financial aid available to all applicants.
12. Any financial aid approved is **not transferable** to another youth participating in the expedition or any expedition.
